1. Called to order at 6:01 p.m.

2. Introduction of New TAC Members
  - a. Linn DeNesti – new member, Arts Representative
  - b. Diego Velasquez – new member, At Large
  - c. Colin Topper – non-voting member, City Council representative
  - d. Zoe Huston – returning member, At Large
  - e. Adrienne Corticelli – new member, Recreation Representative

4. Approval of Minutes from March 6, 2025
  - a. Passes 5-0
5. Review of RAP Technical Advisory Committee Bylaws
  - a. The Bylaws govern the TAC while the Grant Guidelines are for the applicants
  - b. Reminder that TAC members will need to disclose conflicts of interest once applications are received, and recuse themselves from voting and scoring a particular application if they have any conflicts
6. Review and Approval of 2026 RAP Tax Grant Application Documents and Timeline
  - a. Timeline
    - i. Applications will open Friday January 23, 2026
    - ii. Deadline to Apply is February 27, 2026 by 5 p.m.
    - iii. The committee will meet to review all applications on March 19, 2026
  - b. Revising some types on the RAP Guidelines and FAQs and adding in the language for in City limits/on City property.
  - c. Types of preferred projects to fund? New or existing? Will decide on an individual basis based on application and scoring
  - d. Linn brought up notifying applicants of funding status as soon as possible so that they hear from us rather than in the paper. There is a round of TAC recommendations and then Council approval before we can send out official notice.
  - e. Historic Number of Applicants
    - i. 2025 there were 22 applications and 18 were funded
    - ii. 2024 there were 21 applications and 16 were funded
    - iii. 2023 there were 20 applications and 15 were funded
  - f. 25% match is required, in-kind accepted and there is a volunteer rate provided in the budget sheet
  - g. Sandra had a question regarding some of the applicants that were not funded last year, specifically the Childcare project and Moab Solutions – Zoe was part of the review committee last year and explained that the TAC didn't feel that those projects fit with the RAP Mission as well as other applications.
  - h. This raised a question about how the RAP mission should be a part of the basic requirements, and she explained that once you start reading and reviewing applications it

is sometimes more nuanced than ‘this project is for the arts’ - discussion over how to add this to the Criteria and Application

- i. Mission – Supporting and promoting recreational, cultural, arts, and parks facilities and programs to benefit the Moab community
        - ii. Does benefit to the community mean events for the community or does that include financial contributions to the Moab economy by outside organizations hosting events like races here?
        - iii. Agreed on wanting to add a section about how does this project tie to the Mission in the Quality of the proposed project Scoring for the TAC reviewers and in the Application as well so that applicants have the opportunity to address this
      - i. Adoption of documents and timelines with proposed changes in Guidelines of fixing typos, adding the City Property section, adding RAP Mission aligned section in Quality Criteria, and adding an Application question about how the project ties to the RAP Mission. Moved by Adrienne, seconded by Zoe. Passes 5-0
- 7. Discussion and Consideration of Adoption of RAP Tax Project Final Report Form
  - a. Committee liked the form and having consistency of all Grantees filling this out
  - b. TAC would like Staff to add a section for optional upload of other supporting documents
  - c. This form would be required for 2026 grantees, and available but not required for 2025 grantees
  - d. Adoption Passed 5-0
