### Join us Aug. 1 for an Installation Reception at Lions Park

Justin Tyler Tate is this year's Moab Arts Re-Use Residency artist. While in Moab, Justin has been working on constructing an interactive installation out of waste materials such as steel, wood, tires, DC motors, LEDs, Li-ion batteries, and USB devices. The work emphasizes play as a source of power and will illuminate the night and charge devices.



“My artistic practice is an ongoing research based process which looks to develop localized site-specific works while addressing contemporary global problems,” Tate says. “Each project aims to expand simple definitions of art into hybridized manifestations of installation, architecture, engineering, activism, new media, design and dialogical methodologies. I build my work in relation to the landscape, the local community, what materials are available and the unique characteristics of a place.”

Join us on Monday, Aug. 1 from 7 to 8 p.m. for the reveal and a short reception with the artist. The installation is located at Lions Park (U.S. 191 and State Route 128 near the Moab Boulder Park and Pavilion). The reception will immediately follow the artwork reveal.
