Team Rubicon to help Moab property owners with flood cleanup

City and county property owners who need help with clearing debris left by the Aug. 20 Mill Creek flood are encouraged to request assistance from the volunteer group Team Rubicon. This veteran-led disaster response organization will head to Moab soon to provide labor and equipment in the effort to help those residents most affected by the flood clear their properties of flood debris.

To speed up the process, property owners are asked to complete a right-of-entry form in advance of Team Rubicon's arrival in Grand County. This form is required and gives Team Rubicon permission to be present on the property to perform the cleanup assistance work.

The City of Moab is now entering into the final phase of its vital community-wide project to create a vision and strategic action plan for Moab's future.

Moab residents are encouraged to participate in the Sept. 19 Future Summit – a celebration of the visioning process to date. *A special visioning event for youth is scheduled for Sat., Sept. 17.*

These will be the final community engagement events for the Moab – Tomorrow Together Community Visioning process and community participation is crucial.

Future Summit

The Future Summit will be held **Mon., Sept. 19 from 5:30 to 7 p.m.** at the Moab Arts and Recreation Center in the Dance Room, 111 East 100 North in Moab.

The Future Summit will include the launch of the six strategic pillars – key topic areas developed by community members during the process so far that will shape the final Vision and Strategic Action Plan. Attendees will also participate in rapid polling on the strategic pillars and give thoughts during evening. Registration is now open at the website, bit.ly/MoabTomorrowTogether.

The six strategic pillars identified by the community during previous workshops, the Think Tank, and focus groups are:

- **Tourism Trajectory and Economic Diversification** • **Affordability and Equity**
- **Leadership and Decision Making** • **Environmental Stewardship**
- **Housing and Workforce** • **Community Fabric and Wellbeing**

Almost 1,000 community members have participated in the process so far through the March survey, the Community Think Tank, as well as Vision Workshops and Focus Groups held in June and August.


