Red Rock Arts Festival-Oct. 6-9

The 2022 Red Rock Arts Festival is a four-day multimedia, participatory arts festival designed to feed the imagination, incite playfulness, and build community. The weekend features free workshops and events for all ages.

The festival schedule includes events such as a chalk drawing competition with categories for kids and adults; a poetry workshop led by local author Shari Zollinger followed by a reading at Back of Beyond bookstore; a western-themed short film competition and free screening in partnership with the Moab to Monument Valley Film Commission; and a songwriting workshop with local author and musician Brian Laidlaw of The Family Trade. Other events include a family-friendly pottery workshop at Desert Sun Ceramics; a small plein-air competition and art sale; a community mural led by artist Leanna Usher; a block-party-style Street Fest with live music, activities, and artisan vendors; and a series of pop-up installations and performances.

The Arts & Ag Markets end this month, with events on October 6 and Oct. 20 at Swanny


