Equal Pay Plans Available for City Residential Utility Customers

Avoid last minute and late payments by signing up for autopay. We encourage all citizens to set up an Xpress Bill Pay account. This will allow access to your bill in a timely manner and help avoid late payments and late fees.

Set up an Xpress Bill Pay account at moabcity.org/payments

Here's how it works

- We average your last 12 months of billing to determine your Equal Pay amount.
- Your plan is reviewed annually to compare the estimated amount to actual usage. Any difference will be billed or credited based on the option selected during enrollment.
- We monitor your plan year-round and sometimes make changes mid-year to ensure that you do not have a large amount owing at the end of the year.

Advantages of the Residential Utility Service Equal Payment Plan

- Paying the same amount each month (level payments) can help you conveniently budget by minimizing the impact of seasonal swings in water and sewer consumption.
- The account will never become delinquent.

Water Utility Resource Management Plan Coalition Members Focus Group Meeting

The City of Moab and surrounding communities of the Moab/ Spanish Valley are experiencing sustained population growth and steady tourist visitation, leading to increased water demand. In addition, uncertainties about the climate and extended drought have generated concerns regarding water. These issues affect areas of Grand and San Juan counties containing the City of Moab (Moab), the Grand Water & Sewer Service Agency (GWSSA), and the San Juan Spanish Valley Special Service District (SJVSSD). In addressing these concerns, Moab, GWSSA, and SJVSSD have formed a coalition of water providers for the purpose of studying long-term water and policy planning.

Join us by Zoom Dec. 14 at 6 p.m. for an informational meeting and project update.

This virtual meeting, scheduled for Dec. 14 from 6 to 8 p.m., will be a meeting with Coalition members to discuss project status, future activities and to receive feedback from Coalition members. The consultant team will review project scope and purpose, existing data, and discuss future activities and schedule.
